Carson Rajkowski was a TTC Advocate working on the same trail preparation.

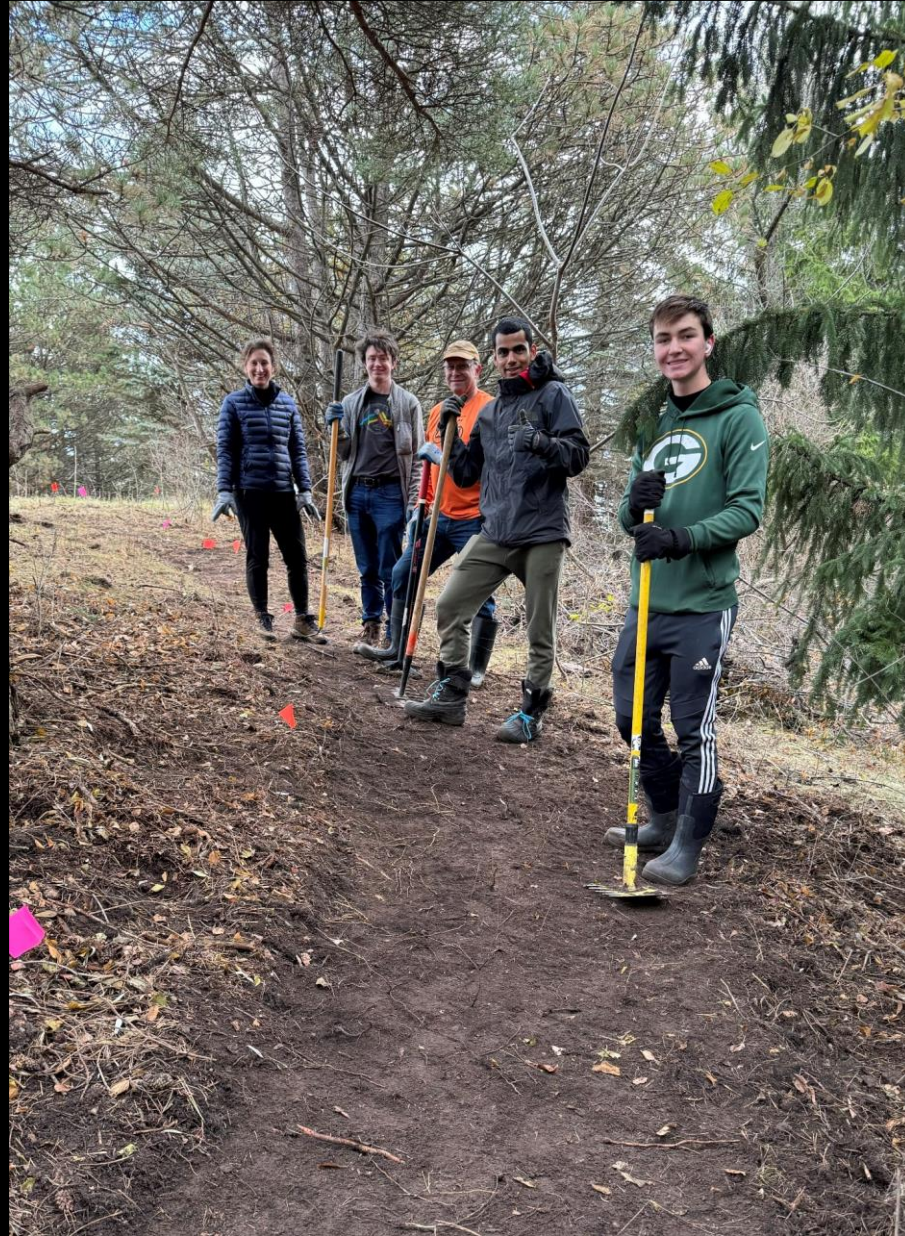


Spooner Composite worked like a steam train.
